Confirmation of compliance with Council Regulation (EU) 2023/1214 of 23 June 2023 amending Regulation (EU) n.833/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of Russia's action destabilizing the situation in Ukraine

Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014, amended – inter alia – by Council Regulations (EU) 2022/428 of 15 March 2022, (EU) 2022/576 of 8 April 2022 and (EU) 2023/1214 of 23 June 2023, contains restrictive measures against Russia in view of Russia's actions to destabilize the situation in Ukraine. The aforementioned amendments concern sanctions against individuals and companies, as well as the restrictions on the import and export of iron, steel and materials. For example:

- According to Article 3g sec.1 of Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 the direct or indirect acquisition of iron and steel products referred to in Annex XVII which are located in Russia or originate in Russia is prohibited.
- The same applies to Belarus in accordance with Article 1q sec. 1 para. b of Council Regulation (EC) 765/2006 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Belarus, which has been amended by Council Regulations 2022/355 of 2 March 2022 and 2022/577 of 8 April 2022.
- According to Art. 3k of Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014 the supply, transfer or export of goods which could contribute in particular to the enhancement of Russian industrial capacities as listed in Annex XXIII is prohibited

Eure inox declares that its suppliers have confirmed to not import any material included in Annex XVII of the aforementioned Regulation
